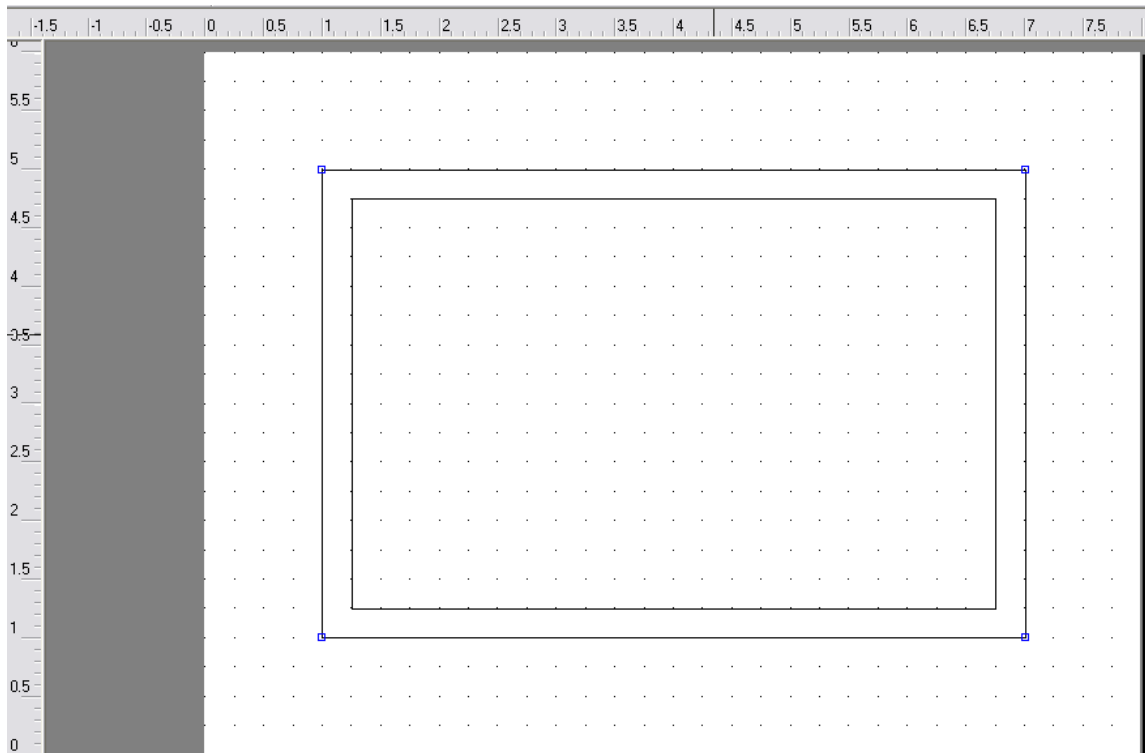


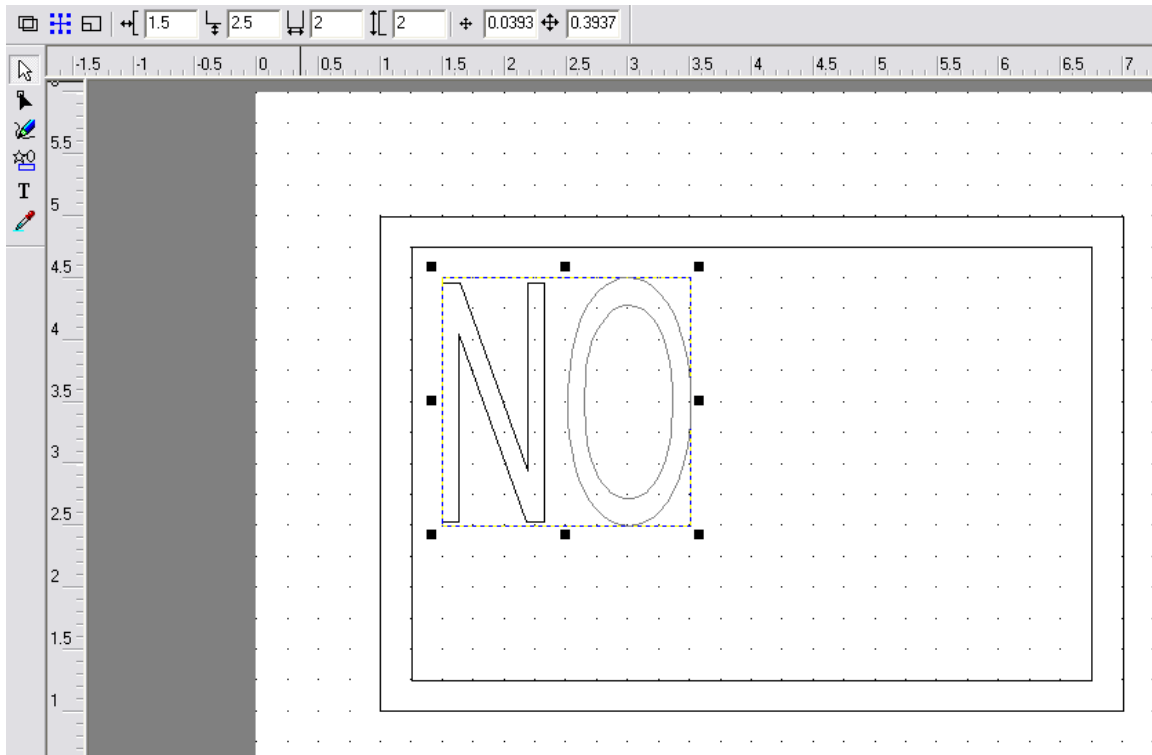
1. Open SignGoLite Express if it is not already open. Today you will be creating a No Smoking Sign.
2. Set up your drawing environment so you can design a 4" x 6" sign.
3. Draw a black border .25" thick, 6 "X 4". To do this draw two rectangles one inside the other .25" from each other as shown in figure 9.1 below. This will be your border.



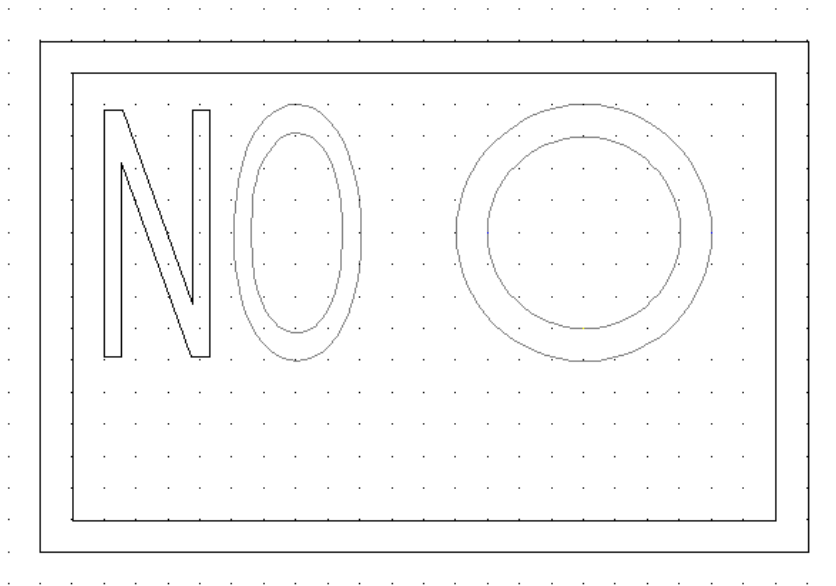
TIP: Setting your grid to .25 and turning on Snap to Grid will make this a snap.

4. Select the Text Tool and draw out a text box. Select Arial for your font. Leave the other settings as you find them. Type the word NO in the text box. Click OK.
5. Select the text you just placed using the object editor (white arrow). In the placement and size tool bar set the width and height of the text to 2". Position the text so it is .5" from the top and left edges of the outside.

6. Draw a circle with a diameter of 2", draw a second circle with a radius of 1.5". Position the two circles so they are concentric as shown below and lined up with the word NO at the top.

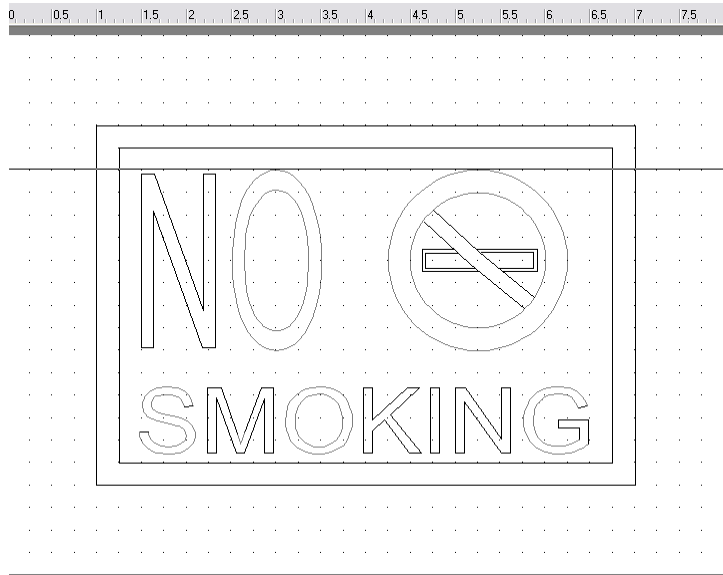

To create the guide rule



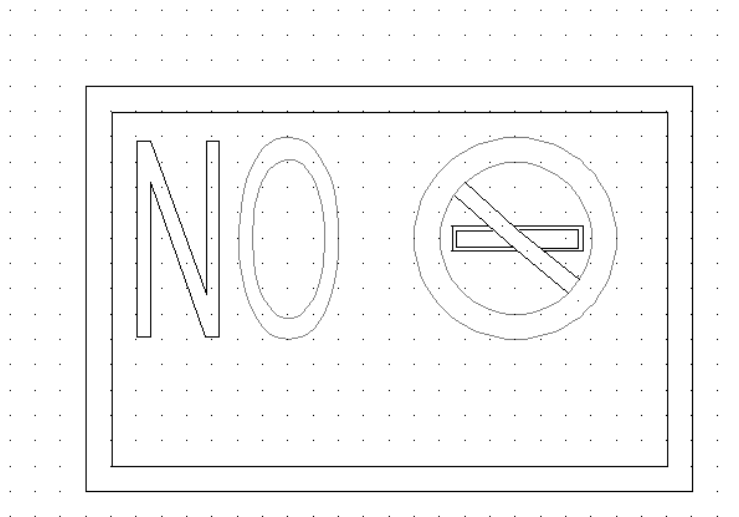
TIP: To align elements on screen, use a guide rule. To create a guide rule, click the ruler on the top or the bottom and drag out onto the screen holding down the mouse. When you are done with it, click it back to the ruler.

7. Draw two lines approximately .25 thick inside the inner circle and add shape to represent cigarette.
8. Center the word smoking below. The word should be 5" wide and .75 tall and in same font as the word NO.

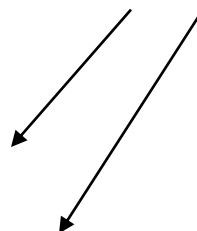
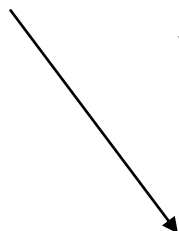

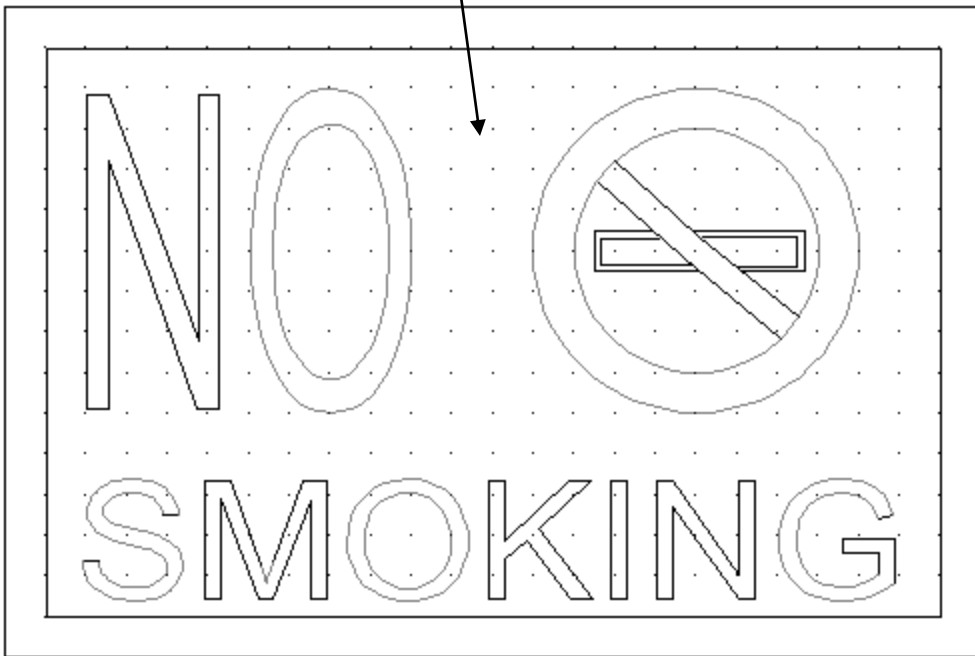
9. When cutting the sign the outside border, circle and cigarette will be cut in black. The words NO SMOKING will be in red. You will assemble the entire sign on a 6"X4" piece of white vinyl.

10. Add registration marks and cut your sign.
11. Apply the sign to a surface (a piece of paper or tag board will do), leave the registration marks on to receive full credit.
12. Put your name(s) on it and turn it into Mr. Clark.
